

Folded Accordion Pocket Map

Use for NBAS Nature Study Trails Pocket Map

An Accordion fold is a document folding method that uses four parallel folds to create 10 panels of equal size – five panels on each side of the paper (3.4 inches per panel for a tabloid (11x17") sized paper).

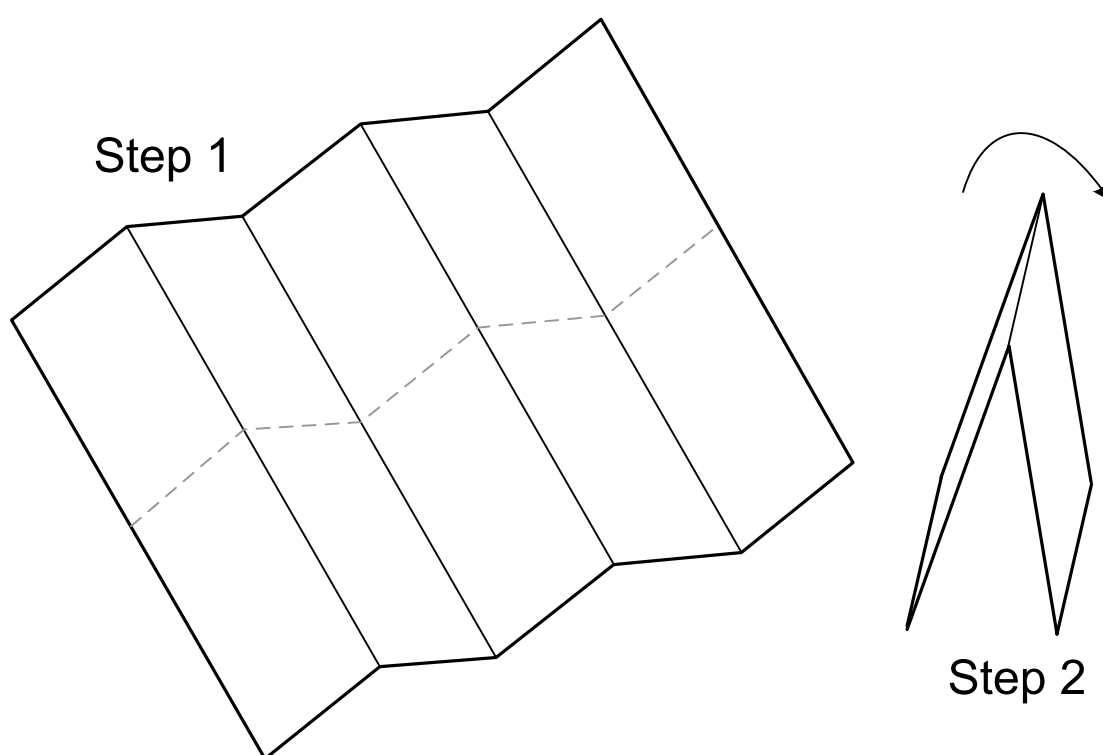
Step 1

The four folds are made in opposite directions, which forms a shape that resembles a zig-zag or a fan fold.

Step 2

The final step is folding the accordion lengthwise to form an a tent.

A fold often used on brochures and mailers in which a zig-zag method of folding appears like the pleats of an accordion or paper fan. The additional fold allows it to fit most shirt pockets.
